Five Public Restrooms for 241,330 West Virginians

On March 1, the Senate passed <u>Senate Bill 540</u>, which creates a new criminal offense, punishable by up to 90 days in jail, for any person who urinates or defecates in a public place other than a public restroom.

SB 540 criminalizes something people must do to survive (and that municipalities already criminalize). What the bill fails to acknowledge is that for most West Virginians a public restroom is not an option.

The West Virginia Center on Budget and Policy reviewed data on city-operated public restrooms in nine of West Virginia's largest cities. See Table 1. Only two cities – Parkersburg and Fairmont – operate **full access restrooms** that are available to the public and open 24 hours a day, 365 days per year. (Notably, the Parkersburg restroom is located inside a police station, while the four Fairmont restrooms are port-a-johns.) In other words, across nine cities, there are five city-operated full access restrooms for 241,330 residents.

Furthermore, these nine cities offer only 24 partial access restrooms that are available to the public and open year-round for certain hours of the day and/or days of the week. Huntington provides only one partial access restroom for its 46,025 residents. Weirton provides one for a geographic area of 11,558 acres.

The lack of public restrooms creates an impossible situation for people who need accessible restrooms: the elderly, pregnant women, people with small children, the unhoused, people with medical conditions, and others. The current landscape gives them no choice but to break the law.
