



Appropriations from General Revenue, Lottery, and Excess Lottery Funds (millions)





Notable increases in the FY 2025 budget compared to FY 2024




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#### **Even With Increases FY 2025 Budget Below FY 2019**


FY 2019 general revenue actual expenditures compared with FY 2024 proposed general revenue expenditures, inflation adjusted to December 2023 dollars (millions)

FY 2014 general revenue proposed expenditures compared with FY 2025 proposed general revenue expenditures



Notable FY 2025 general revenue surplus appropriations and FY 2024 surplus supplemental appropriations



## **Personal Income Tax Down Sharply in FY 2025**


FY 2023 actual personal income tax collections compared to FY 2025 estimated personal income tax collections



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#### General Revenue Collections Down \$285 Million So Far in FY 2024


General Revenue collections, first six months of the fiscal year, FY 2023 and FY 2024 (millions)

Estimated trigger threshold in FY 2024 Above Base Budget Compared With Enacted New Spending Coming onto Base Budget Through FY 2027


